Who are You to Judge Me?

In Regards to, those who feel entitled to judge others. My word to you is, who made you judge over me? Who are you to judge me? To size me up, to compare me to others or yourself? As it is written;

* ... with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged of you, or of man's judgment: yea, I judge not mine own self. (1Co 4:3 KJV)

* For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby justified: but he that judgeth me is the Lord. (1Co 4:4 KJV)

* Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God. (1Co 4:5 KJV)

* ... work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. (Phi 2:12 KJV)

* Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: ... (Luk 6:37 KJV)

* For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again. (Mar 7:2 KJV)

* ... why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ. (Rom 14:10 KJV)

Who are You to Judge Me?

- * Who art thou that judgest another man's servant? to his own master he standeth or falleth. Yea, he shall be holden up: for God is able to make him stand. (Rom 14:4 KJV)
- * Thou shalt not hate thy brother in thine heart: (Lev 19:17 KJV)
- * ... all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; (Rom 3:23 KJV)
 - * As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: (Rom 3:10 KJV)
- * Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: (2Pe 1:10 KJV)
- * If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? (1Jo 4:20 KJV)
- * We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not *his* brother abideth in death. (1Jo 3:14 KJV)
- * Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him. (1Jo 3:15 KJV)
- * Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. (Gal 6:1 KJV)
- * ... repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance. (Act 26:20 KJV)
- * Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another; (Rom 12:10 KJV)
- * ... if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. (Jam 3:14 KJV)
- * This ... *is* earthly, sensual, devilish. (Jam 3:15 KJV)
- * ... the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all *men*, apt to teach, patient, (2Ti 2:24 KJV)
- * In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; (2Ti 2:25 KJV)

- * ... which is after godliness; (Tit 1:1 KJV)
- * ... brotherly kindness; ... (2Pe 1:7 KJV)
- * And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. (1Pe 4:8 KJV)
- * Charity suffereth long, *and* is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, (1Co 13:4 KJV)
- * Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; (1Co 13:5 KJV)
- * Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth; (1Co 13:6 KJV)
- * ... of them that believe to the saving of the soul. (Heb 10:39 KJV)
